fixed mindset

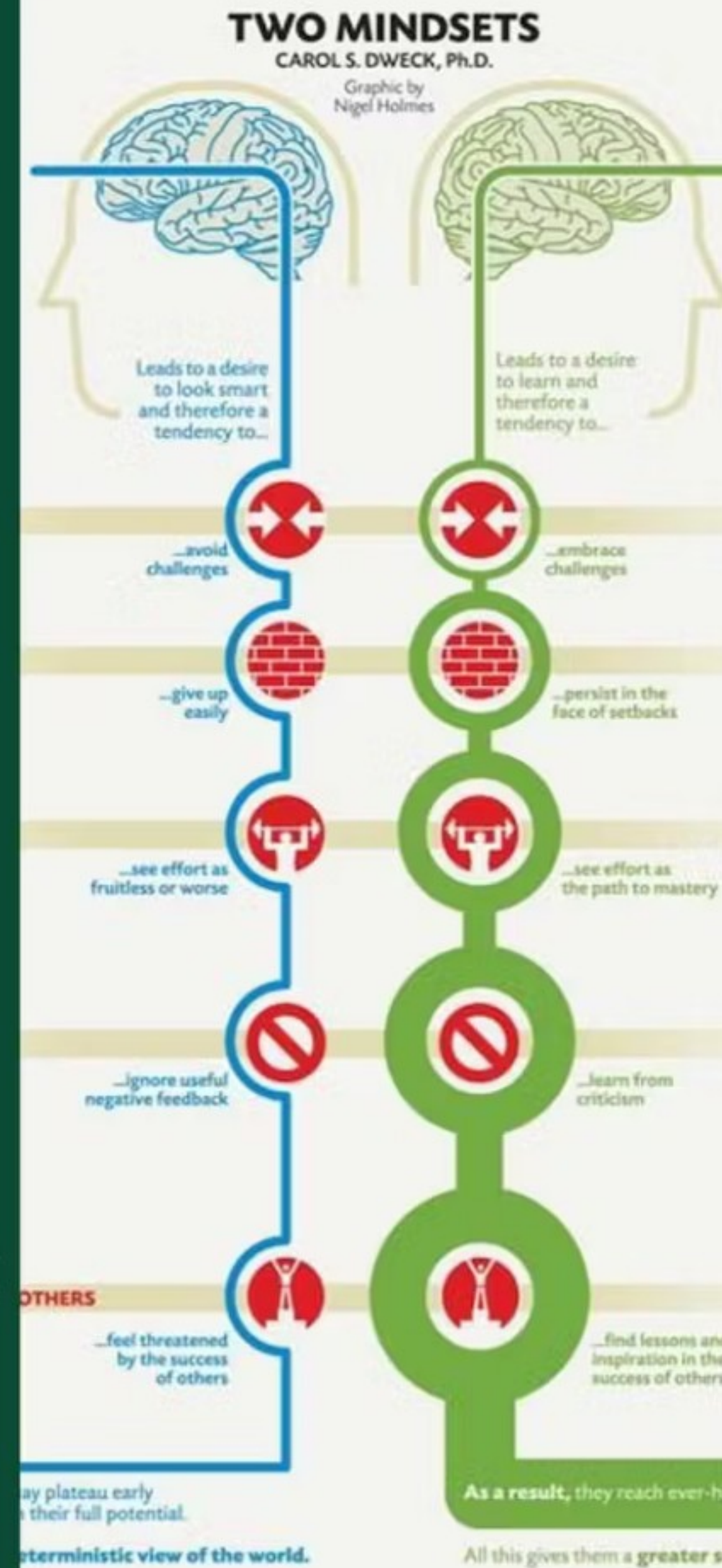
a belief that our intelligence, character and creative abilities are **fixed and unchangeable**

a belief that we can improve our intelligence, character and creative abilities **through effort**

student characteristics

focus on learning

viewing 'not understanding' as an opportunity to grow

recognising feedback as a positive aspect of learning

How can we help our students develop a growth mindset?

Reshaping the evaluation system from emphasis on memory to analytical skills
